

CLUB USE POLICY

This club use policy has been formulated by our club members, approved by the board with the goal of anticipating any and all club use requests.

In an effort to avoid scheduling conflicts with other club members, all persons requesting use of the club must contact the calendar coordinator prior to scheduling any club activities, to assure that the club has not already been committed for other activities. This includes all playdown games, make-up games, and playoff games, in addition to the following.

1) **Benevolent/Charity Auctions** - When approached by a club member regarding donating a charity auction item that includes curling at the club, the following rules apply: i) There must be a club member as sponsor. ii) The club sponsor must be present at the event. iii) All such events shall occur on the 2nd Saturday in November and must be scheduled prior to October 1st of that year. All such charity auction items are to happen on the same day. Once the 5 sheets are spoken for, no other such events maybe scheduled for that year. More than one organization can hold an event on that Saturday. iv) The number of participants shall be in increments of 8, up to a maximum of 40. v) The sponsor(s) shall arrange for instructors. Two instructors are recommended per sheet. vi) The sponsor(s) shall arrange for needed ice help. vii) All participants shall sign a liability waiver. viii) The club will not provide any food or drink. ix) The organization(s) can bring in whatever food or drink they want. x) The organization(s) are responsible for club clean up after the event.

2) **Businesses** - i) There is a fee of \$25 per person (curlers & observers). ii) All participants must sign a waiver. iii) The club will provide a minimum of 1 instructor per sheet - plus - plastic glasses, napkins, ice and water. iv) Businesses can bring in

whatever food or drink they want. v) The business is responsible for club clean up after the event.

3) **School Groups** - i) There is a fee of \$5 per student (curlers & observers). ii) Parents must sign a waiver ahead of time. iii) Two instructors are recommended per sheet. iv) The club will provide water after the event.

4) **Youth Groups** - i) The group must have a club member as sponsor. ii) The club sponsor must be present at the event. iii) There is a fee of \$5 per child (curlers & observers). iv) Parents must sign a waiver ahead of time. v) Two instructors are recommended per sheet. vi) The club will provide water after the event. vii) The youth group can bring in whatever food or drink they want. viii) The youth group is responsible for club clean up after the event.

5) **Adult Non-Profit or Service Organizations** (i.e. Lions, Church Groups, Auxiliaries, etc.) – i) The group must have a club member as sponsor. ii) The club sponsor must be present at the event. iii) There is a \$50 facility fee. iv) There is also a fee of \$5 per person (curlers & observers). v) The sponsor(s) shall arrange for instructors. Two instructors are recommended per sheet. vi) The sponsor(s) shall arrange for needed ice help. vii) All participants shall sign a liability waiver. viii) The club will not provide any food or drink. ix) The organization can bring in whatever food or drink they want. x) The organization is responsible for club clean up after the event.

6) **Member Family Groups** – i) A donation for the use of the facility is appreciated. ii) All participants shall sign a liability waiver. iii) The club will not provide any food or drink. iv) The family group can bring in whatever food or drink they want. v) The family group is responsible for club clean up after the event.

7) **Member Non-Curling Social Events** – i) A donation for the use of the facility is appreciated. ii) All participants shall sign a liability waiver. iii) The club will not provide any food or drink.

iv) The club member can bring in whatever food or drink they want. v) The club member is responsible for club clean up after the event.

8) **Non-member Events** - No event can be scheduled at the club without a club member as sponsor, except for businesses and school groups as described above. The club sponsor must be present at the event.

9) Exceptions to these rules must obtain board approval in advance of the event.
